
## LEAD is unsafe for children

causes behavioral and developmental adverse e ects in children at doses much lower than those that cause obvious symptoms. There is no e ective treatment for these adverse e ects. The only way to know if children have been exposed to lead is to get a blood test<sup>2</sup>.

Blood test results show that hundreds of children across Santa Clara County have been exposed to lead<sup>3</sup>.

The most at risk are children who are 1 to 5 years old who live in housing built before 1978 or who live close to sources of lead pollution like general aviation airports.
